

Immerse yourself in a culturally rich day- visit an Indigenous venue, meet an Indigenous caterer, and speak with successful Indigenous tourism operators all in the region where you work and play.

Our workshop has undergone an extensive research process to support the development of this program-connecting with both the Indigenous community and tourism operators including DMOs to identify needs, knowledge gaps, and priorities.

This program intends to:

- Help non-Indigenous stakeholders and tourism operators understand the history and cultural diversity of Indigenous communities in Alberta;
- Promote respect, responsibility, and reciprocity as a foundational approach to relationship building between Indigenous communities and businesses and non-Indigenous tourism partners for the benefit of both.

To date, ITA has trained over 400 Industry professionals, which has lead to increased understanding, partnership creation and growth of the Indigenous Tourism Industry, making Alberta the Canadian leader in Indigenous Tourism growth, marketing and experiences.
